C. Eligibility

Athlete Eligibility
<p>All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors). Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate at MINSK 2019.</p> <p>Age Requirements The players must be born before 1 January 2004 (must be minimum 16 years old at the end of 2019); however, minimum two (2) players have to turn 19 years or older on the year of the competition.</p> <p>Medical and Anti-Doping Requirements To be eligible to participate at MINSK 2019, all athletes must satisfy the medical requirements according to the EOC Medical and Anti-Doping Guidelines. To be eligible to participate at MINSK 2019, all athletes must comply with doping control process in accordance with the EOC Medical and Anti-Doping Guidelines and the EOC Anti-Doping Rules.</p> <p>Additional FIBA Requirements A player: a) must hold the legal nationality of that country; and b) must present a passport of that country issued by the competent authorities before the 1st of January of the calendar year prior to the competition (01.01.2018); and c) may not have previously played for the national team (5v5 or 3x3) of another country in an Official Competition of FIBA (see Art. 2-21 of the FIBA Internal Regulations); and d) must be registered at play.fiba3x3.com with a confirmed account.</p>

D. Qualification Process

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

E. Confirmation Process for Quota Places

FIBA will publish the list of qualified teams according to the FIBA 3x3 Federation Ranking as of 1 November 2018.

By 1 January 2019, MEGOC on behalf of the EOC and the FIBA will inform, in writing, the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places.

By 15 January 2019, the NOCs will have to confirm, in writing, to MEGOC if they wish to use these quota places as detailed in **Section G**.

F. Reallocation of Unused NOC Quota Places

If obtained through the qualification process and allocated quota place is declined by the NOC or is not confirmed by the NOC by the deadline, the quota place in that event will be reallocated to the next best team according to the FIBA 3x3 Federation Ranking as of 1 November 2018.

This process will be repeated until all places are allocated.

By 15 February 2019, the FIBA will reallocate all unused quota places and inform, in writing, MEGOC.
