4.1 Sports program:

4.2 Dates and venue:

The Shooting competition will take place at the **Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center**, from **Tuesday June 28 to Sunday July 3, 2022**.

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Shooting competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022**.

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the ICMG Technical Commission, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the Sport Director of the OCMG Oran 2022, will decide on **Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee (NOC) of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Shooting competition will be held in accordance with the ISSF regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, the ISSF rules will apply.

7. Technical organization:

FATS under the supervision of the Technical Delegate of the ISSF, is responsible for the technical organization and running of the shooting competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition management, in accordance with the regulations of the ICMG and the ISSF in force on **January 1, 2022**, unless special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The precise arrangements for the organization of the Shooting competition will be made according to the number of participants.

7.2 Drawing of the lots:

The drawing of lots to determine the order of positions allocated to the fencers, the composition of the teams and the order of shooting will be carried out on **Sunday, June 26, 2022 at 10:00 am**, at the meeting room of the Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center, under the control of the technical delegates of the ISSF. The information will be provided to the delegations during the technical meeting and will be available on the notice boards of the Technical Shooting Information Center (TIC).

7.3 Competition system:

The competition system will be established according to the ISSF technical regulations for each event. There will be a competition phase and a final.

8. Competition venue:

The shooting competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center, 2.9 km kilometers from the Mediterranean Village.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition area will respect the specificities established in the ISSF regulations for all the events selected

8.2 Warm-up area:

The area for warm-ups will be the one designated for each event.

8.3 Changing rooms:

Participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with toilets.

8.4 Rest room for athletes:

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.5 Press tribune:

Accredited media will have a tribune and a working room at their disposal.

8.6 Sports equipment:

All sports equipment and technical equipment used in shooting competitions and training must comply with the standards established in the ISSF regulations, in force on **January 1, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The shooters will deposit their weapons and ammunition in a space reserved for this purpose and which will be equipped with security measures according to the law in force.

9.Training:**9.1 Training venue:**

The shooting training for the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center, 2.9 km from the Mediterranean Village.

9.2 Services in the training venue:

9.2.1 Changing rooms:

Participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with toilets.

9.2.2 Rest room for athletes:

In the training venue, athletes will have a rest room with water, energy drinks and fruits.

9.3 Media during training:

The training sessions will be open to the media but not to the public. The competition director will be the person empowered to modify this standard whenever necessary.

9.4 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:

NOCs will receive the program of training sessions at the latest **Ten (10) Days** before the DRM.

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM.

9.4.1 Pre-competition:

In general, the competition management will make available to the teams, for a daily training session, the venue designated for this purpose, Three (3) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, **June 25, 26 and 27 June, 2022**

9.4.2 During the competition:

The Competition management will assign a daily training session one (1) day before each event, according to the ISSF rules.

During the technical meeting on **Monday, June 27, 2022**, the Organizing Committee will present the training program for the competition phase. During the technical meeting, each NOC will then be able to present their specific training needs, which will be assessed for inclusion in the training program for the competition phase.

The teams will receive information on the training sessions upon arrival at the Sport Information Center SIC of the Mediterranean Village and at the TIC of shooting.

10. Participation:

All member NOCs of the ICMG, of which the national shooting federation is a member of the ISSF, will be able to participate in the Shooting competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

Athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and comply with the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the ISSF.

Each NOC may participate in the Shooting competition with two (2) men shooters per event and two (2) women fencers per event.

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system. The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 23:59 (Algerian time)** the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

Confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and any subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given to the head of mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on **Monday, June 27, 2022, at 12:30 am**, at the meeting room of the Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center.

The meeting will take place in accordance with ISSF regulations, under the direction of the ISSF Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The ISSF Technical Delegate
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- Coaches (one per team),
- Team doctors (one per team),
- The Director of the Shooting competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

13. Health services:

13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venues:

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

Polyclinic of the Mediterranean Village will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will serve as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

13.2 Doping control:

Anti-doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG's Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the ISSF and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the ISSF.

14. Judges-referees:

14.1 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of each event included in the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, an international Jury of Appeal will be formed in order to resolve the claims.

If the ISSF Technical Delegate does not chair the Jury of Appeal, the ISSF will appoint, through him, the President of the jury which will be composed according to the regulations in force.

As a general rule, and except as otherwise provided by the ISSF, the Jury of Appeal will be composed of one (1) President and two (2) members chosen from the list of six (6) qualified representatives of the participating countries.

The list of members of the jury of appeal will be communicated by the Technical Delegate during the technical meeting.

When processing a claim, the members of the Jury of Appeal who are nationals of the countries concerned, must abstain.

14.2 Competition Jury:

The Shooting competitions at the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will be held under the control of juries composed of international judges appointed by the ISSF, the composition of the juries will be as follows:

- Jury for the rifle: President and two (2) members,
- Jury for the pistol: President and two (2) members,
- Jury for the ranking: President and two (2) members,
- Jury for skeet: President and two (2) members.
- Jury for trap: President and two (2) members.

At least one (1) member of the jury from each category will attend the arms and equipment check.

14.3 Referees-Judges:

The ISSF technical delegate will designate the referees for the different events. All referees must be international referees.

15. Claims:

All claims must comply with ISSF procedures. Claims must be submitted by the NOC in question in writing in Arabic, French or English, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the ISSF regulations.

All claims will be presented to the TIC of shooting which in turn will forward them to the secretariat of the jury of appeal, as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG, as well as to the President of the committee of judges and to the Director of the shooting competition.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

16. Sports clothing:

16.1 Athletes sports clothing:

Participants in the Shooting competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with the regulations of the ISSF and the ICMG.

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, provided it does not appear exaggeratedly for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and the ISSF.

The official medal ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising. The athletes will have to stand on the podium with the official clothing of their NOC.

16.2 Clothing of the referees:

During the competition, international referees must wear the ISSF's regulatory clothing.

16.3 Bibs:

The bibs, provided by the OCMG Oran 2022, worn by the shooters, must be fully visible during the entire competition.

The bibs will be given to the team leaders at the TIC of Shooting located at the Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center.

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

Possibly several ceremonies can take place on the same day, which will be communicated in due course.

17.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place:

Gold medal and diploma to the participant ranked first in each event including mixed events

17.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal and diploma for the participant ranked second in each event including mixed events

17.1.3 Third place:

Bronze medal and diploma to the participant ranked third in each event including mixed events

17.1.4 Fourth to eighth place

Diploma to participants ranked from fourth to eighth place in each event including mixed events

18. Calendar and times:

The Shooting competition will take place from **Tuesday June 28 to Sunday July 3, 2022**, at the Hassi Ben Okba Shooting Center, according to the following schedules (schedules are provisional and may change depending on the final number of entries:

Each team or athlete concerned would then be informed at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance.



19. Technical offices:

Two offices will provide information specific to the shooting competition

- TIC of Shooting, located on the competition site.
- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

These offices will provide information on competition schedules, training sessions, transportation, participant lists and results.

20. Approval of regulations:

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.
