4. Events and dates:**4.1 Sports program:**

The Cycling competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

Cycling	
Men	Women
Road race	Road race
Time trial, individual	Time trial, individual

4.2 Dates and Venues:

The Cycling competition will take place at the 5th Periphery, **on Thursday June 30th "Time trial" and Saturday July 02nd, 2022 at the CCO "Road race".**

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Cycling competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time) on Saturday, Friday March 25, 2022.**

Each road race, men-women, will take place if a minimum of 20 cyclists have registered for the event by the date and time indicated above.

Each individual time trial event, men and women, will take place if a minimum of 16 cyclists for the men event and 12 cyclists for the women event have registered on the date and time indicated above.

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the ICMG Technical Commission, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the Oran 2022 sports organization's president, will decide, **on Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The various cycling events will be held in accordance with the UCI regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical questions, the UCI regulations will be applied.

7. Technical organization:

The ACF, under the supervision of the UCI Technical Delegate, is responsible for the technical organization and running of the cycling events during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition management, in accordance with the regulations of the ICMG and the UCI in force on **January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG. The precise arrangements for the organization of the cycling competition will be made according to the number of participants.

7.2 Time trial:

7.2.1 Drawing of the lots:

A draw will be made to establish the starting order for the individual time trial. This will take place during the technical meeting on **Saturday June 27, 2022**.

The starts will be in order with an interval of three (3) minutes between each rider.

Each rider will be accompanied by a vehicle. These vehicles will be neutral technical assistance vehicles with at least one mechanic on board.

The name of the NOC will appear on the vehicle at the race convoy which will be the only one authorized to follow the rider. This vehicle will be able to transport the equipment and spare parts, wheels and other repair equipment required.

During the race, this vehicle may in no case be at the level of the rider, and it must be kept behind at a distance of ten (10) meters, according to the UCI technical regulations.

7.3 Road race:

For the road race, the riders must be on the start line at least fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled time in order to sign the start sheet.

7.4 Track cycling:

The Organizing Committee of the competition will plan two (2) track cycling visits:

- The first, for the individual time trial event, will take place on **Wednesday, June 29, 2022**
- The second, for the road race event, will take place on **Friday July 01st, 2022**.

8. competition venues:

The Cycling competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place for:

- The individual time trial, on an 5th Periphery is located at 2.5 km far from the Mediterranean Village.
- The road race will take place on the road circuit, the start will be given at the CCO which is located at 6.7 kilometers far from the Mediterranean Village.

8.1 Competition area:

8.1.1 Time trial individual event:

The competition area will be 25 kilometers circuit for men, and 18 kilometers circuit for women.

8.1.2 Road race event:

The competition area will be a road race of 143 kilometers for men and 88 kilometers for women.

8.2 Rest area for athletes:

The athletes will have a rest area equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.3 press area:

Accredited media will have a press area at their disposal.

8.4 Sports equipment:

All sports equipment and technical equipment used during cycling competitions and training must comply with the standards established in the UCI regulations, in force on **January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

9. Training:

9.1 Training venues:

The Competition Director will suggest a choice of routes to follow for team training. This information will be distributed upon their arrival.

No training program will be established and the teams will therefore be able to decide freely on the day and time of their training, but must inform the Sports Information Center SIC of their training. Traffic will not be cut off on the proposed roads.

10. Participation:

All member NOCs of the ICMG, of which the national cycling federation is a member of the UCI, will be able to participate in the cycling competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022. Athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and respect the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the UCI.

Each NOC can participate in the Cycling competition with:

- A maximum of eight (8) riders for the men's road race.
- A maximum of six (6) riders for the women's road race.

Two (2) men riders and two (2) women riders for the individual time trial.

Each rider must:

Be in possession of an international license issued by his national federation and validated by the UCI for the year 2022, respect, accept and apply the UCI regulations.

Participation is open to men's club cyclists and those belonging to UCI continental teams. Participation will not be allowed to those who belong to professional teams in the UCI World Teams and UCI Professional Continental Teams category.

Participation is open to women's cycling clubs and to those belonging to the UCI professional teams of UCI women's teams.

11.Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 are open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system.

The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

Confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and any subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given to the head of mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on **Saturday June 27, 2022, at 4:00 p.m.**, at the meeting room of the Mediterranean Village.

The meeting will take place in accordance with UCI regulations, under the direction of the UCI Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The UCI Technical Delegate.
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission.
- Jury President.
- The race commissaires.
- The team leaders (one per country)
- Coaches (one per team)
- The Director of the Cycling competition of the OCMG Oran 2022

13. Health services:

13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at the competition venues:

13.1.1 In the Mediterranean Village:

The Mediterranean Village polyclinic will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services,

Ambulance teams will act as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.2.2 On the competition venues:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

13.2 Doping control:

Doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG's Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the UCI and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a test will receive a written notification of the moment from which the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and he / she will be sanctioned in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and of the UCI.

14. Judges - referees:

14.1 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of each event included in the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, international appeal judges will be appointed to deal with any claims.

If the UCI Technical Delegate does not chair the Jury of Appeal, the UCI will appoint, through him, the President of the jury, which will be composed according to the UCI regulations in force.

14.2 Commissaires:

The commissaires of the cycling competition at the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will be appointed by the ACF with the exception of the president of the commissary panel who will be appointed by the UCI.

15. Claims:

All claims must comply with UCI procedures.

Claims must be presented, by the NOC in question, in writing, in Arabic, French or English, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash, as fixed by the UCI regulations.

All claims will be presented to the TIC of cycling, which in turn will forward them to the secretariat of the Jury of Appeal, as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

As stipulated by the UCI regulations (art. 1.2.125), and while respecting article 12.1.012 in disciplinary matters, no claim will be allowed against the facts of the race.

16. Sports clothing:

Participants in the cycling competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with UCI and ICMG regulations.

All participants must wear a hard helmet during all events

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be authorized, provided that it does not appear exaggeratedly for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and the UCI

The official Medal Ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising.

16.1 Bibs:

The bibs and the frame plates provided by the OCMG Oran 2022 to the riders must be fully visible during the entire competition.

This material will be handed over during the technical meeting on **June 27, 2022.**

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

17.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place:

Gold medal and diploma for the cyclist ranked first in each event.

17.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal and diploma for the cyclist ranked second in each event.

17.1.3 Third place:

Bronze medal and diploma for the cyclist ranked third in each event.

17.1.4 Fourth to eighth place:

Diploma to cyclists ranked fourth through eighth in each event.

18. Calendar and times:

The Cycling competition will take place **on June 30 and July 02, 2022**, according to the following schedules:

(The schedules are provisional and could change according to the final number of entries)

The organizers, and for justified reasons, will also have the right to modify the competition schedules, with the agreement of the Technical Delegate.

Each team or athlete concerned would then be informed at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance.

19. Technical offices:

Two offices will provide information specific to the Cycling competition:

- Cycling TIC, located in Mediterranean Village.
- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

These offices will provide information on competition schedules, training sessions, transportation, lists of participants and results.

20. Approval of regulations:

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.

This Technical Manual was approved by the ICMG on March 12, 2022.
