4. Events and dates:

4.1 Sports program:

The Boxing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

4.2 Dates and venue:

The Boxing competition will take place in the **EMEC Hall** from **Sunday June 26 to Friday July 01, 2022.**

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Boxing competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the Technical Commission of the ICMG assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the president of the organizing commission sports center of OCMG Oran 2022, will decide **on Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Boxing competition will be held in accordance with the IBA regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, the IBA rules will apply.

7. Technical organization:

The FAB, under the supervision of the IBA Supervisor, is responsible for the technical organization and the conduct of the Boxing competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition Management, in accordance with the ICMG and IBA regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, unless specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Precise arrangements for the organization of the Boxing competition will be made depending on the number of participants.

7.2 Draw of fights:

The draw to determine the order of the bouts will take place on **Saturday, June 25, 2022** during the technical meeting, after each delegation has confirmed the final list of entries for its athletes.

7.3 Competition system:

The competition system will include a phase of preliminary fights, depending on the number of participants and a phase of Quarter-Finals, Semi-finals and Finals.

The direct elimination system will be applied in which the loser will be eliminated automatically.

In accordance with IBA regulations and the rules followed for international competitions and tournaments, the bout will consist of three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes each, with a one (1) minute break between each.

7.4 Medical examination:

All participants in the Boxing competition will undergo a medical examination before the official weigh-in, under the supervision of the IBA Supervisor

This examination will be carried out by the officials appointed for IBA and a team of boxing specialists appointed by the FAB medical services.

The results of the examinations will be noted on the individual competition booklets which each athlete must carry with him at all times.

7.5 Weigh-in:

The weigh-in of the athletes will be carried out in the weighing room of the Mediterranean Village, in accordance with the IBA regulations in force, and in the presence of the IBA Supervisor or persons designated by him.

The first weigh-in will begin on **Sunday June 26, 2022, from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. at the Mediterranean Village.**

For the following days of competition, the weigh-in will be carried out **between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m. at the Mediterranean Village.**

8. Competition venue:

The Boxing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the **EMEC Hall**, 14,1 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village. The hall has a capacity of 1000 spectators.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition area will include two (2) rings of 7.80m x 7.80m, - measures of the interior of the quadrilateral formed by the ropes -, at a maximum height of 1.10m from the ground level, according to IBA specifications for international competitions.

An area near the ring reserved for referees, members of the IBA jury, members of the medical committee and technicians (FOP).

Access to this area will be strictly controlled and reserved for duly authorized persons.

8.2 Warm-up area:

Next to the competition area, athletes will have a space for warm-up. This area will be clearly separated from the competition area.

8.3 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

8.4 Rest room for athletes:

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.5 Press tribune:

Accredited media will have a tribune and a working room at their disposal.

8.6 Sports equipment:

All sports equipment and technical equipment used during boxing competitions and training must be approved by the AIBA, according to the regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

9. Training:

9.1 Training venues:

9.2 Services in training venues:

9.2.1 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal changing rooms equipped with showers, toilets and scales.

9.2.2 Rest room for athletes:

In the training venues, athletes will have a rest room with water, energy drinks and fruits.

9.3 Media during training:

The training sessions will not be open to the media and the public. The competition director will be the person empowered to modify this standard whenever necessary.

9.4 Pre-competition:

In general, the competition Management will provide the teams with a training room equipped with a training ring and punching bags, this room will be available as soon as the delegations arrive, it will be made available **Three (03) days before** the start of the competition, that is to say, **Thursday 23 June 2022** until the last day of competition.

If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venues for training Four (4) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Wednesday 22 June 2022, depending on the availability of infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Heads of Mission Manual.**

10. Participation:

All the member NOCs of the ICMG, whose national federation is a member of AIBA, will be able to participate in the boxing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

The athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and comply with the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the IBA.

Each NOC can participate in the Boxing competition with one (1) athlete per weight category and Gender that is to say with a maximum of Seventeen (17) athletes if participating in all categories masculine and feminine. They can also register a replacement (1) in the long list

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system. The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French. The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, **before 23:59 (Algerian time), Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, **before 23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

Confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and any subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given to the head of mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place **on Saturday June 25, 2022, at 11:00 am,** at the competition venue.

The meeting will be conducted in accordance with IBA regulations under the direction of the IBA Supervisor. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The IBA Supervisor,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- Coaches (one per team),
- The Director of the Boxing competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

13. Health services:

13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venues:

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

Polyclinic of the Mediterranean Village will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will serve as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

13.2 Doping control:

Doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG's Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the IBA and the World Anti-Doping Code. .

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the AIBA.

14. Judges-referees:

14.1 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of each event included in the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, an international Jury of Appeal will be constituted in order to resolve the claims.

As a general rule, and except as otherwise provided by the IBA, the Jury of Appeal will be composed of one (1) President and two (2) members chosen from the list of six (6) qualified representatives of the participating countries.

When processing a claim, the members of the Jury of Appeal who are nationals of the countries concerned, must abstain.

14.2 Officials:

The IBA will appoint all the officials for the Boxing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

14.3 Referees – judges:

IBA referees will be appointed by IBA to officiate during the Boxing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

15. Claims:

All claims must comply with IBA procedures. Claims must be presented, by the NOC in question, in writing, in Arabic, French or English, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the IBA regulations.

All claims will be presented to the TIC of boxing, which will in turn forward them to the secretariat of the Jury of Appeal, as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

16. Sports clothing:

Participants in the Boxing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with IBA and ICMG regulations.

The 10 oz. blue and 12 oz. red competition gloves for athletes will be provided by Oran 2022 OCMG, also a helmet for female boxers

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, if it is not exaggerated for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and AIBA.

The official Medal Ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising. The athletes will have to stand on the podium with the official clothing of their NOC.

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

17.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place:

Gold medal and diploma for the boxer ranked first in each weight category.

17.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal and diploma for the boxer ranked second in each weight category.

17.1.3 Third places (O2):

Bronze medal and diploma to the two boxers ranked third in each weight category.

17.1.4 Fifth to eighth place:

Diploma to boxers ranked fifth to eighth place in each weight category.

18. Calendar and times:

The Boxing competition will take place **Sunday June 26 to Friday July 01, 2022**, according to the following schedules; Two Sessions;

- 1st session from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- 2nd Session; from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.

The organizers, and for justified reasons, will also have the right to modify the competition schedules, with the agreement of the Supervisor.

Each team or athlete concerned would then be informed at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance.

19. Technical offices:

Two offices will provide information specific to the Boxing competition:

- TIC of boxing, located on the competition site.
- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

These offices will provide information on competition schedules, training sessions, transport, participant lists and results.

20. Approval of regulations:

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.

This Technical Manual was approved by the ICMG on March 12, 2022
