4. Events and dates:

4.1 Sports program:

The Bowls Sports competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

Each team will include two athletes, the one participating in the precision shooting in Pétanque or in individual in Raffa being a member of his doublet.

4.2 Dates and venue:

The Bowls competition will take place at the LOFA "Es Senia" Complex from **Sunday 26 to Wednesday 29 June 2022**.

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Bowls competitions will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022**.

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the Technical Commission of the ICMG, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the president of the Commission of the Sports Organization of OCMG Oran 2022, will decide, **on Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee (NOC) of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Bowls competitions will be held in accordance with the regulations of the IFs members of the World Confederation of Bowls Sport (CMSB) governing each of the disciplines of the program, in force on **January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will be applied.
- For technical questions, the regulations of the IFs concerned will be applied.

7. Technical organization:

The FASB and the FARB, under the supervision of the CMSB Technical Delegate, are responsible for the technical organization and conduct of the Bowls competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition Management, in accordance with the regulations of the ICMG and the IF Concerned in force on **January 1, 2022**. Unless special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Precise arrangements for the organization of the Bowls competition will be made according to the number of participants.

7.1.1 Petanque: doublets men and women:

The teams are distributed by draw in lots of 4 or in groups according to the number of registered countries, with seeds determined according to the classification of the last test world championship.

Up to 8 registered (s) the competitions take place in round robin. Beyond that, the formula of lots will apply

a. Formula in lots

In each group, the teams compete by full draw for the first match. In the second match the winners play against each other, as well as the losers. The winner of the winners is qualified for the quarter-finals - or the semi-finals depending on the number of teams entered as the first group and the loser of the losers is eliminated

The other two teams face off in a play-off in which the winner in turn qualifies for the quarter-finals- or semi-finals depending on the number of teams entered as group runner-up, and the loser is eliminated. The quarter-finals or semi-finals pit the first of one pool against the second of another and the winners advance to the semi-finals or the finals according to a pre-established table. Then two-person finals: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

The games take place in 13 points but with a maximum time limited according to the provisions of the international regulations of the FIPJP if none of the teams has reached this score within the regulation time: one hour plus two additional leads.

In the event of a tie at the end of the two additional ends, a new end will be discussed during which the goal can never be lost; if it leaves the playing field it will be put back in place

b. Group formula

In each group each team faces all the others.

The semi-finals pit the first of one group against the second of the other and the winners advance to the final. Then two-person finals: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

The games take place in 13 points but with a maximum time limited according to the provisions of the international regulations of the FIPJP if none of the teams has reached this score within the regulation time: one hour plus two additional throws.

7.1.2 Pétanque: Precision shooting men and women

All athletes participate in a qualifying event, the classification of which is established according to the rules in force for the World Shooting Championship.

Then depending on the number of registered competitors:

- The first four are qualified for the quarter-finals by taking ranks 1 to 4

The next eight take part in a second qualifying round, the results of which are cumulated for each of them with those of the first round. The first four are qualified for the quarter-finals by taking ranks 5 to 8.

The final table is as follows:

A : 1 vs 8

A vs B

B : 4 vs 5

: Winner A/B vs Winner C/D (GOLD Final)

C : 3 vs 6

C vs D

D : 2 vs 7

A/B Loser vs C/D Loser (BRONZE Final)

Or:

- The first two are qualified for the semi-finals by taking ranks 1 and 2.

The next eight take part in a second qualifying round, the results of which are cumulated for each of them with those of the first round. The first two are qualified for the semi-finals by taking ranks 3 and 4.

The qualifiers compete in the semi-finals: 1 against 4 and 2 against 3. Then two-person finals: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

7.1.3 Lyonnaise: Progressive shooting men and women:

All the athletes participate in two qualifying events, the results of which are cumulative for each of them. The running order is determined by drawing lots for the first round. It is done in the reverse order of the results for the second round.

The 4 or 8 best scores are qualified, ranked from 1 to 4 or from 1 to 8 according to their totals. In the event of a tie, the one who achieved the best score on a lap is ranked first; if the equality persists, a sudden death test is organized.

Qualifiers compete in eliminatory matches, either according to the number of registered competitors:

In the quarter-finals according to the following table:

A : 1 vs 8

A vs B

B : 4 vs 5

: Winner A/B vs Winner CD (GOLD Final)

C : 3 vs 6

C vs D

D : 2 vs 7

A/B Loser vs C/D Loser (BRONZE Final)

- In the semi-finals directly: 1 against 4 and 2 against 3. Then finals for two: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

7.1.4 Lyonnaise: Precision shooting men and women:

In groups of 4, the athletes take part in two qualifying events, the results of which are cumulative for each of them. The distribution in the groups and the order of passage are determined by drawing lots.

The 4 or the 8 best scores are qualified, classified from 1 to 4 or from 1 to 8 according to their totals. In the event of a tie, the one who achieved the best score on a lap is ranked first; if the equality persists, a sudden death test is organized.

Qualifiers compete in eliminatory matches, either according to the number of registered competitors:

- In the quarter-finals according to the following table:

A : 1 vs 8

A vs B

B : 4 vs 5

Winner A/B vs Winner CD (GOLD Final)

C : 3 vs 6

C vs D

D : 2 vs 7

A/B Loser vs C/D Loser (BRONZE Final)

- In the semi-finals directly: 1 against 4 and 2 against 3. Then two-person finals: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

7.1.5 Raffa: doublets and singles according to the same regulations - men and women:

The teams are distributed by draw in lots of 4 or in groups according to the number of registered countries, with seeds determined according to the classification of the last world championship.

Up to 8 registered (s) the competitions take place in round robin. Beyond that, the formula of lots will apply.

a) Formula in lots

In each lot the teams or athletes compete by full draw for the first match.

In the second match the winners play against each other, as well as the losers. The winner of the winners is qualified for the semi-finals as first group and the loser of the losers is eliminated.

The other two teams or the two athletes face each other in a play-off in which the winner in turn qualifies for the quarter-finals or semi-finals as runner-up, and the loser is eliminated.

The quarter-finals pit the first from one pool against the second from another and the winners advance to the semi-finals according to a pre-established table. Then two-person finals: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

The games take place in 12 points maximum or one hour, time of the current end at the time of the stop to end. In the event of a tie, an additional throw is played.

b) Formula in groups

In each group each team or each athlete faces all the others.

The semi-finals pit the first of one group against the second of the other and the winners advance to the final. Then two-person finals: one for the bronze for the losers, one for the gold for the winners.

The games take place in 12 points maximum or one hour of time, the leads in progress at the time of the stop to end. In the event of a tie, an additional throw is played.

7.2 Drawing of the lots:

The draw to determine the order of the start lists will take place on **Friday, June 24, 2022**, during the technical meeting, and after each delegation has confirmed the entries of its athletes.

The drawing of lots will take place under the control of the CMSB Technical Delegate, in the presence of the official representatives of the participating teams.

8. Competition venue:

The Bowls competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the LOFA complex "Es Senia" 17.6 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village. The complex has a capacity of 500 Spectators.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition area will include Six (6) pitches for Raffa, twelve (12) pitches for Pétanque and Four (4) pitches for Lyonnaise in accordance with the rules of the corresponding IFs, members of the CMSB.

8.2 Warm-up area

The warm-up area will be the same as the competition area.

8.3 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

8.4 Rest room for athletes:

The athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.5 Press tribune:

Accredited media will have a tribune and a working room at their disposal.

8.6 Sports equipment:

All sports equipment and technical equipment used during the Bowls competitions and training must comply with the standards established in the regulations of the corresponding IFs, members of the CMSB, in force on **January 1, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

9. Training:**9.1 Training venue:**

Bowls training for the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the LOFA Complex (Es Senia) 17.6 km from the Mediterranean Village.

9.1.1 Training calendar and schedule:

Athletes will have the following venue at their disposal, according to the times indicated below:

9.2 Services in training venue:**9.2.1 Changing rooms:**

The participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

9.2.3 Rest room for athletes:

In the training venues, athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruit.

9.3 Media during training:

The training sessions will be open to the media but not to the public. The competition director will be the person empowered to modify this standard whenever necessary.

9.4 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:

The NOCs will receive the program of the training sessions at the **latest Ten (10) Days** before the DRM.

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM.

9.4.1 Pre-competition:

In general, the competition management will make available to the athletes, for a daily training session, the venue designated for this purpose, Three (3) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, **June 23, 24 and 25, 2022**. If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venue for training Four (4) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Wednesday 22 June 2022**. **Depending on the availability of infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Heads of Mission Manual.**

9.4.2 During the competition:

During the technical meeting the Organizing Committee will present the training program for the competition phase

During the technical meeting, each NOC will then be able to present their specific training needs, which will be assessed for inclusion in the training program for the competition phase.

All NOCs will have to confirm that they will use their training session, by 5:00 pm the day before training; otherwise, said session will be made available to other NOCs

The teams will receive information on the training sessions upon arrival at the Sports Information Center (SIC) of the Mediterranean Village and at the Bowls Technical Information Center (TIC).

10. Participation:

All the member NOCs of the ICMG, whose national federation is a member of the respective IF of the CMSB, will be able to participate in the Bowls competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

The athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and respect the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the CMSB.

Each NOC can participate in the Sport Bowls competition with:

- For Pétanque : two (2) men athletes and two (2) women athletes, who may participate in both the doublets and the precision shooting event.
- For the Raffa: two (2) athletes in the men's tournament including one (1) who will also participate in the individual event and two (2) athletes in the women tournament including one (1) who will also participate in the event individual. If an NOC does not participate in the Doubles event, it may enter one (1) athlete in the Men's Individual event and one (1) athlete in the Women's Individual event.
- For the Lyonnaise: up to two (2) men athletes (one for progressive shooting and another for precision shooting) and up to two (2) women athletes (one for progressive shooting and another for precision shooting).
- Each team will include two athletes, the one participating in the precision shooting in Pétanque or in individual in Raffa being a member of his doublet.

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 are open to all athletes of the NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC standard.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system.

The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

The confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and all possible later eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given in advance to the Chef de Mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on Saturday June 25, 2022, at 11:00 am, in the Mediterranean Village meeting room. The meeting will take place in accordance with the regulations of the corresponding IFs, under the direction of the CMSB Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The Technical Delegate of the CMSB,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- The coaches (one per team),
- The team doctors (one per team),
- The Directors of the Ball Sports competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

13. Health services:

13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venues:

During the Oran 2022 Mediterranean Games, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

The Mediterranean Village polyclinic will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will act as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

13.2 Doping control:

Doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG's Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the CMSB and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, in the time and form established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned, as well as his pair (in case of participation in duplicates), in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the corresponding IFs.

14. Judges-referees:

14.1 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of each event included in the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, an international Jury of Appeal will be constituted in order to resolve the claims.

If the CMSB Technical Delegate does not chair the Jury of Appeal, CMSB will appoint, through him, the President of the jury which will be composed according to the regulations in force.

As a general rule, and except for specific provisions of the CMSB, the jury of appeal will be composed of one (1) President and two (2) members chosen from the list of six (6) qualified representatives of the participating countries.

The list of members of the Jury of Appeal will be communicated by the Technical Delegate during the technical meeting.

When processing a claim, the members of the jury of appeal who are nationals of the countries concerned, must abstain.

14.2 Referees:

The Bowls competitions at the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will be refereed as follows:

- Pétanque: Four (4) referees,
- Lyonnaise: Four (4) referees,
- Raffa: Four (4) referees

The referees will be appointed by the CMSB and their names will be communicated by the Technical Delegate during the technical meeting on **Friday June 24, 2022.**

14.3 Referees committee:

The referees committee will be composed of four (4) members:

- Chairman: the representative of CMSB,
- Two (2) representatives: from the FASB and the FARB,
- Two (2) members representing the participating countries,

The referee committee will be responsible for:

- Designate the referees for each event,
- Organize the meetings of the referees,
- Apply the rules of the corresponding IFs,
- Check the material and the installation.

15. Claims:

Any claims must comply with CMSB procedures. claims must be presented, by the NOC in question, in writing, in English, Arabic or French, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the CMSB regulations.

All claims will be presented to the TIC for Bowls, which in turn will forward them to the secretariat of the Jury of Appeal, as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG. If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

16. Sports clothing:

16.1 Sports clothing of Athletes:

Participants in the Bowls competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with the regulations of the corresponding IFs and of the ICMG.

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, provided that it does not appear exaggerated for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and the CMSB.

The official medal ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and publicity. The athletes will have to stand on the podium with the official clothing of their NOC.

16.2 Clothing of the referees:

During the competition, the international referees must wear the regulatory clothes required by the respective IFs.

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

17.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place

Gold medal and diploma to the participant or to each member of the pair ranked first.

17.1.2 Second place

Silver medal and diploma to the participant or to each member of the pair ranked second.

17.1.3 Third place:

Bronze medal and diploma to the participant or to each member of the pair ranked third.

17.1.4 Fourth to eighth place:

Diploma to participants or to each member of the pair ranked fourth to eighth place.
