4. Events and dates:

4.1 Sports program:

The Handball competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

4.2 Dates and venues:

The Handball competition will take place at the 24 Février sports Hall “Arzew” for men **from Monday 27 June to Wednesday 06 July 2022** and the El Hachemi Hantaz sports Hall “Ain El Turck” for women from **Wednesday 29 June to Wednesday 06 July 2022** (The two ½ finals and finals of both genders will take place in the Olympic Complex sports Hall).

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Handball competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for men's events and six (6) countries for women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time) on Friday March 25, 2022.**

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the ICMG Technical Commission, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the president of the competition of the OCMG Oran 2022, will decide on **Monday May 30, 2022**, the canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Handball competition will be held in accordance with the IHF regulations in force **on January 1, 2022**, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, the IHF regulations will apply.

7. Technical organization:

The FAHB, under the supervision of the IHF Technical Delegate, is responsible for the Handball competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the matches will be resolved by the competition sub-commission, in accordance with the ICMG and IHF regulations in force **on January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The precise arrangements for the organization of the Handball competition will be made according to the number of participants.

7.2 Drawing of the lots and composition of groups:

Depending on the number of countries registered for the Handball competition, on **Friday March 25, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. (Algerian time)**, the Competition Management and the IHF Technical Delegate will define the organization system for the men's and women's competition.

The drawing of lots for the composition of the groups will take place, according to the ICMG and IHF regulations, on **Monday May 30, 2022**

The committee for the draw is made up of:

- IHF Technical Delegate,
- President of the ICMG Technical Commission or his representative,
- Chairman of the sports organization commission of OCMG Oran 2022.

Heads of mission from participating countries, the media and the public will be able to attend the draw.

In order to avoid possible imbalances between the groups and to designate the seeds of the series, the committee for the drawing of lots will take into account the level of the participating teams and, especially, the results of the last Mediterranean Games, as well as the information it has at its disposal.

7.3 Groups:

Tournament organized with the participation of six (6) teams

Only one group will be closed in which all the teams will play against each other. The final will be played between the two teams ranked first in the group and the third and fourth place will be played between the teams ranked 3rd and 4th.

The schedule of matches will be determined by drawing lots, following the system established by IHF regulations.

Tournament organized with the participation of seven (7) to ten (10) teams

The participating teams will be divided into two (2) groups A and B.

In each group, all the teams will play against each other to determine the ranking.

Each group will play according to the league system, all against all, in a single turn.

Semi-finals

The first two (2) ranked teams from each group will advance to the semi-finals, according to the following system:

1st semi-final	2nd semi-final
1° A - 2° B	1°B – 2°A

Finals

The meetings will be as follows:

- The winners of the two semi-finals for 1st and 2nd place.
- The losers of the two semi-finals for 3rd and 4th place.

The matches to decide the ranking from 5th place will be organized according to the number of participating teams.

Tournament organized with the participation of eleven (11) teams

The participating teams will be divided into three (3) groups A, B and C. Group A, with three (3) teams and groups B and C, with four (4) teams. In each group, all the teams will play against each other to determine the ranking. The first two (2) teams from group A will advance to the next phase as well as the first three (3) from groups B and C. Each group will play according to the league system, all against all, in a single round.

Quarter-finals

The first two (2) ranked teams from group A and the top three (3) from groups B and C will play the matches in the following order:

The matches for places from 5th to 8th will be played between the teams which have lost the quarter-finals.

The 5th and 6th place matches will be played by the winners of the 5th to 8th ranking matches.

Matches for 7th and 8th place will be played by the losers of the 5th to 8th place ranking matches.

The losers of the quarter-finals will play the matches for 5th to 8th places.

The matches for 5th and 6th place will be played by the winners of the 5th to 8th ranking matches.

The matches for the 7th and 8th places will be played by the losers of the classification matches of the 5th to the 8th.

Winner 1st match –
Winner 4th match

Winner 2nd match –
Winner 3rd match

The losers of the quarter-finals will play the matches for 5th to 8th place.

Finals:

The following matches will be played:

- Winners of the two semi-finals for 1st and 2nd place.
- Losers of the two semi-finals for 3rd and 4th place.

7.4 Ranking system:

7.4.1 Point system:

Points will be awarded according to IHF regulations.

- Match won = 2 points
- Tied match = 1 point
- Lost match = 0 point

If two (2) or more teams in the same group have the same number of points, the ranking will be determined according to the IHF technical regulations.

The system of support matches, which will be by direct elimination, will comply with IHF technical regulations.

7.5 Competition commission:

The competition commission for Handball will be as follows:

- President: Technical Delegate of the IHF.
- Three representatives of the participating countries, chosen by the IHF Technical Delegate.
- Director of the competition for Handball of the OCMG Oran 2022.

A delegate from the ICMG Technical Commission will be part of this commission, when present.

The competition commission is responsible for:

- Course of the competition,
- Appointment of referees,
- Appointment of table assistants and competition secretaries,
- Application of sanctions for inappropriate behavior of athletes and officials during the game,
- Final ranking of the teams.

8. Competition venues:

The men's Handball tournament of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the 24 Février sports Hall "Arzew", located 28.9 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village. The Hall has a capacity of 2000 spectators.

The women's Handball tournament of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will be held at the El Hachemi Hantaz sports Hall "Ain El Turck" located 26.3 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village. The hall has a capacity of 1000 spectators.

The men's and women's semi-finals and finals will take place in the Olympic complex sports Hall, 04 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village with a capacity for 6000 spectators.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition area of the two venues will include one (1) synthetic competition field, 40m X 20m, approved by the IHF.

8.2 Warm-up area:

The warm-up area will be the same as that of the competition.

8.3 Changing rooms:

Participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers, toilets and massage tables.

8.4 Rest room for athletes:

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.5 Press tribune:

Accredited media will have a tribune and a working room at their disposal.

8.6 Sports equipment:

The official competition ball will be the one chosen and approved by the IHF.

For warm-ups before matches, the organization will provide each team with 10 balls similar to that of the competition.

All sports equipment and technical equipment used in Handball competitions and training must comply with the standards established in the IHF regulations, in force **on January 1, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

9. Training:

9.1 Training venues:

9.2 Services in the training venues:

9.2.1 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers, toilets and massage tables.

9.2.2 Rest room for athletes:

In the training venues, athletes will have a rest room with water, energy drinks and fruit.

9.3 Media during training:

The training sessions will be open to the media but not to the public. The competition management will be empowered to modify this standard whenever necessary.

9.4 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:

The NOCs will receive the program of the training sessions at the latest Ten (10) Days before the DRM.

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM.

9.4.1 Pre-competition:

In general, the competition management will make available to the teams, for a daily training session, the venues designated for this purpose, **two (2) days** before the start of the competition, that is to say, **Friday June 24, 2022 for men and Sunday June 26, 2022 for women.**

If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venues for training Five (5) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Wednesday June 22, 2022 for men** and Five (5) Days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Friday June 24, 2022**, depending on the availability of the infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Manual of Heads of Mission.

The training sessions will have a maximum duration of one and a half hour (1h30).

9.4.2 During the competition:

Competition management will assign a daily training session lasting between 50 minutes and an hour (depending on availability), in one of the designated venues.

During the technical meeting **on Sunday June 26, 2022**, the Organizing Committee will present the training program for the competition phase. During the technical meeting, each NOC will then be able to present their specific training needs, which will be assessed for inclusion in the training program for the competition phase.

All NOCs will need to confirm that they will use their training session by 5:00 p.m. the day before training. Otherwise, said session will be made available to the other NOCs. They may, also the National Handball Federation of their country, request, before 5:00 p.m., additional training which may be allocated to them, from 8:00 p.m. on the same day, depending on the availability of the venues.

The teams will receive information about the training sessions upon arrival at the Sports Information Center SIC of the Mediterranean Village and the Handball Technical Information Center TIC.

10. Participation:

All member NOCs of the ICMG, of which the national handball federation is a member of the IHF, will be able to participate in the Handball competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

The athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and respect the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the IHF.

Each NOC may participate in the Handball competition with one (1) men team and one (1) women team.

A Handball team is made up of a maximum of sixteen (16) players.

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system.

The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

Security deposits for team sports:

NOCs participating in the Handball tournament must make a deposit **of 3,000 US Dollars** in the OCMG Oran 2022 bank account, **before Friday April 15, 2022**, for each registered team. If an NOC decides not to participate in a team competition or if it ultimately does not take part in a competition, this deposit will not be refunded. The NOCs which will take part in the team competitions for which they have registered will be reimbursed for their deposit in the bank account to which they have given the reference. Bank charges relating to both the deposit and the reimbursement will be borne by the NOC concerned.

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

Confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and any subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given to the head of mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on **Sunday, June 26, 2022, at 03:00 p.m.**, at the meeting room of the Mediterranean Village.

The meeting will take place in accordance with IHF regulations, under the direction of the IHF Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The IHF Technical Delegate,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- The referees,
- The Director of the Handball competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

Each representative must come to this meeting with the players 'and goalkeepers' outfits, in order to select during the meeting which one will be used for each match.

13. Health services:**13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venues:**

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any accredited athlete or official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

Polyclinic of the Mediterranean Village will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will serve as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

13.2 Doping control:

Doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the Medical and Anti-Doping Commission of the ICMG and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the IHF and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned (as well as his team) in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the IHF.

14. Jury – Judges :**14.1 Referees:**

Each NOC taking part in the Handball competition will register two (2) international IHF referees at its expense. The names of the referees must be included in the entry form by name.

For each of the Handball competitions on the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, the composition of the referee team will be as follows:

- Two (2) referees appointed by the IHF,
- Two (2) international referees from each participating country (brought by each NOC with its delegation),
- Six (6) referees appointed by the FAHB,
- The members of the secretariat and the competition timekeepers, appointed by the FAHB.

14.2 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of the events of each sport on the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, international appeal judges will be appointed to deal with any claims.

If the IHF Technical Delegate does not chair the Jury of Appeal, the IHF will appoint, through him, the President of the jury which will be composed according to the regulations in force.

As a general rule, and except as otherwise provided by the IHF, a Jury of Appeal will be composed of one (1) president and two (2) members chosen from a list of six (6) qualified persons from among the representatives of the participating countries.

The list of members of the Jury of Appeal will be communicated by the Technical Delegate during the technical meeting.

When processing a claim, the members of the appeal jury who are nationals of the countries concerned, must abstain.

15. Claims:

All claims must comply with IHF procedures. Claims must be presented by the NOC in question, in writing, in Arabic, French or English within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the IHF regulations.

All claims will be presented to the Handball TIC which will in turn forward them to the secretariat of the appeal jury as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded but not otherwise.

16. Sports Clothing:

Participants in the Handball competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with the IHF and ICMG regulations.

Each team must have two (2) sets of shirts of different colors (light and dark). These colors must be indicated at the time of confirmation of entry. Athletes must wear the same number throughout the competition. Numbers 1 to 99 can be used. Captains may wear a four-centimeter-wide armband of a color clearly different from that of the jersey on their arm.

The team placed second on the competition schedule will be required to change their jersey if the color matches the first place one.

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, provided it is not exaggeratedly displayed for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and IHF.

The official Medal Ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising. Athletes will be required to step onto the podium wearing the official clothing of their NOC.

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition

17.1 Medals and diploma:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place:

Gold medal to the players of the first- ranked team.

17.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal to the players on the second-ranked team.

17.1.3 Third place:

Bronze medal to the players of the team ranked third.

17.1.4 Fourth to eighth place:

Diploma to players of teams ranked from fourth to eighth place.

18. Calendar and schedule:

The preliminary phase of the Men's tournament will take place at the 24 Février sports Hall "Arzew".

The preliminary phase of the Women's tournament will take place at the El Hachemi Hantaz Sports Hall "Ain El Turck". except the ½ finals and finals of both genders will take place in the Olympic Complex sports Hall.

The organizers, and for justified reasons, will also have the right to modify the competition schedules with the agreement of the Technical Delegate.

19. Technical offices
