4. Events and dates:

4.1 Sports program:

The Judo competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

4.2 Dates and venue:

The Judo competition will take place at the **Mohammed ben Ahmed CCO Hall 03 and 06**, from **Wednesday June 29 to Friday July 1, 2022**.

5. Competition rules and code of conduct:

The Judo competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time) on Friday March 25, 2022**.

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the ICMG Technical Commission, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the Sports Director of the "OCMG- Oran 2022", will decide, **on Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Judo competition will take place in accordance with the IJF regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, the IJF rules will apply.

7. Technical organization:

The FAJ, under the supervision of the Technical Delegate of the IJF, is responsible for the technical organization and running of the Judo competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition Management, in accordance with the regulations of the ICMG and the IJF in force on **January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The precise arrangements for the organization of the Judo competition will be made according to the number of participants.

7.2 Draw of fights:

The draw to determine the order of the fights will take place on **Tuesday June 28, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.** at the Mediterranean Village. before the technical meeting.

The draw will take place under the control of the Technical Delegate of the IJF, in the presence of the official representatives of the participating teams.

7.3 Competition system:

The Judo competition system at the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will be that indicated by the IJF regulations: direct elimination with double repechage.

The "CARE" system will be used.

7.4 Weigh-in:

In accordance with IJF regulations, weigh-ins will be carried out in the Mediterranean Village weighing room, in the presence of the IJF Technical Delegate. The unofficial weigh-in will take place the day before each competition between **6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.**, and the official weigh-in between **7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.**

8. Competition venue:

The Judo competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Mohammed ben Ahmed CCO **Hall 03 and 06**, 6,7 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village. The hall has a capacity of 1500 spectators.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition area will consist of three (3) tatami mats measuring 14m X 14m, approved by the IJF. The competition area is 10m X 10m

8.2 Warm-up area:

In the same venue and next to the competition area, athletes will have a space for warm-ups, with three (3) tatami mats similar to those for the competition.

8.3 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal changing rooms for men and women equipped with showers, toilets and scales.

8.4 Rest room for athletes:

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.5 Press tribune:

Accredited media will have a tribune and a working room.

8.6 Sports equipment:

All sports equipment and technical equipment used in Judo competitions and training must comply with the standards established in the IJF regulations, in force **January 01, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the CIJM.

9. Training:

9.1 Training venues:

Judo training for the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place in the following venues:

Three (3) independent training areas of 11m x 11m and equipped with tatami mats similar to those of the competition will be available.

9.2 Services in training venues:

9.2.1 Changing rooms:

The athletes will have at their disposal changing rooms for men and women equipped with showers, toilets and scales.

9.2.2 Rest room for athletes:

In the training venues, athletes will have a rest room with water, energy drinks and fruits.

9.3 Media during training:

The training sessions will be open to the media but not to the public. The Competition Director will be the person responsible for changing this standard whenever necessary.

9.4 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:

NOCs will receive the program of training sessions at the latest Ten **(10) Days** before the DRM.

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM.

9.4.1 Pre-competition:

In general, the Competition Management will assign a daily training session of one (1) hour in the training venue Three (3) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, on **Sunday June 26, 2022**

If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venues for training five (5) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Friday June 24, 2022**. Depending on the availability of infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Heads of Mission Manual.

The teams will receive information on the training sessions upon arrival at the Sport Information Center SIC of the Mediterranean Village and at the Technical Information Center TIC of Judo.

9.4.2 During the competition:

During the technical meeting on **Tuesday June 28, 2022**, the organizing committee will present the training program for the competition phase. During the technical meeting, each NOC will then be able to present their specific training needs, which will be assessed for inclusion in the training program for the competition phase.

10. Participation:

All member NOCs of the ICMG, whose national federation is a member of the IJF, will be able to participate in the Judo competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

The athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and respect the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the IJF.

Each NOC can participate in the Judo competition with one (1) athlete per weight category that is to say with a maximum of fourteen (14) participants in case of participation in all categories.

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system.

The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

Confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and any subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given to the head of mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on **Tuesday June 28, 2022, at 2:00 p.m.**, at the meeting room of Mediterranean Village.

The meeting will take place in accordance with the IJF rules, under the direction of the IJF Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The Technical Delegate of the IFJ,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- Judges and referees,

- Coaches (one per team),
- Team doctors (one per team),
- The Director of the Judo competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

12.1 Arbitration meeting:

The arbitration meeting will take place on **Tuesday, June 28, 2022**, at **3:00 p.m.**, at the meeting room of Mediterranean Village

13. Health services:

13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venues:

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

Polyclinic of the Mediterranean Village will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will serve as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

Three (3) doctors with good knowledge of Judo rules will be present in the competition area.

13.2 Doping control:

Doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the

collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the IJF and the World Anti-Doping Code. .

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the IJF.

14. Judges-referees:

Each NOC taking part in the Judo competition must register with its delegation one (1) international referee to officiate during the competition. The name of this referee must be included in the entries form by name.

The IJF will appoint one (1) Referee Director for the competition, as well as two (2) referees who will not be nationals of Mediterranean countries.

The IJF Arbitration Director will appoint the arbitration commissioners for each tatami; these will in turn designate the referees for each bout.

The FAJ, under the control of the Technical Delegate of the IJF, will appoint the officials - judges necessary to officiate during the competition.
The FAJ will provide referees to the IJF when needed.

15. Claims:

Any claim must comply with the procedures of the IJF. Claims must be presented by the NOC in question in writing in English, Arabic or French, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the IJF regulations.

All claims will be presented to the Judo TIC which will in turn forward them to the secretariat of the Appeal Jury, as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

16. Sports clothing:

16.1 Clothing for athletes and coaches:

Participants in the Judo competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, as well as their respective coaches, must wear sports clothing in accordance with the regulations of the IJF and the CIJM.

During each fight, the athletes will wear their Judogis of different colors (white or blue). No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be authorized,

provided it does not appear exaggeratedly for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and the IJF.

The official Medal Ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising. The athletes will have to stand on the podium with the official clothing of their NOC.

16.2 Clothing of international referees:

During the competition, international referees must wear the official IJF uniform.

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

17.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place:

Gold medal and diploma for Judoka ranked first in each weight category (men and women).

17.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal and diploma for Judoka ranked second in each weight category (men and women).

17.1.3 Third places (O2):

Bronze medals and diploma to the two Judokas ranked third in each weight category (men and women).

17.1.4 Fifth to eighth place:

Diploma to Judoka ranked fifth to eighth place in each weight category (men and women).

18. Calendar and times:

The Judo competition will take place from **Wednesday June 29 to Friday July 01, 2022**, according to the following schedules (schedules are provisional and may change depending on the final number of entries:

The organizers, and for justified reasons, will also have the right to modify the competition schedules, with the agreement of the Technical Delegate.

Each team or athlete concerned would then be informed at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance

19. Technical offices:

Two offices will provide information specific to the Judo competition:

- TIC of Judo, located on the competition site.
- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

These offices will provide information on competition schedules, training sessions, transportation, participant lists and results.

20. Approval of regulations:

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.

This Technical Manual was approved by the ICMG on march 12, 2022.
