4. Events and dates:

4.1 Sports program:

The table tennis competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

4.2 Dates and venue:

The Table Tennis competition will take place at **Mohammed Ben Ahmed CCO Hall 01 and 02** from **Sunday 26 to Thursday 30 June 2022**.

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Table Tennis competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time) on Friday March 25, 2022**.

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the ICMG Technical Commission, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the OCMG Oran 2022 Sports Director, will decide **on Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee (NOC) of the list of events that are canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Table Tennis competition will be held in accordance with the ITTF regulations in force on **January 01, 2022**, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, ITTF rules will apply.

7. Technical organization:

FATT, under the supervision of the ITTF Technical Delegate, is responsible for the technical organization and running of the Table Tennis competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition management, in accordance with the ICMG and ITTF regulations in force on **January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The precise arrangements for the organization of the table tennis competition will be made according to the number of participants.

The seeds will be designated according to the men and women world ranking in force fifteen (15) days before the start of the competitions.

7.2 Drawing of the lots:

The draw to determine the order of the competition will take place on **Saturday, June 25, 2022 at 10:00 a.m.**, during the technical meeting and once the delegations have confirmed the final list of entries of their athletes.

7.3 Individual events:

7.3.1 First phase:

The players will be grouped into eight (8) pools and will play a round robin tournament. The winner of a match will earn two (2) points, the loser one (1) point and, if the match does not take place or end, zero (0) points.

The first two (2) ranked from each pools move on to the next phase. In the event of a tie, ITTF rules will apply.

The matches will be played to the best of seven (7) sets.

7.3.2 Second phase:

These players will be divided into four (4) groups of four (4) players each, while respecting the criterion according to which the players who have faced each other in the first phase cannot compete against each other in the second.

Likewise, it will be avoided that players from the same country end up in the same group.

The matches will be played to the best of seven (7) sets.

7.3.3 Final phase:

The first two (2) ranked players from each group of the second phase will advance to the final phase, knockout.

The matches will be played to the best of seven (7) sets.

7.4 Team events:

Event procedure by equipment.

Before a team match, the right to choose A, B or X, Y will be decided by lot and the team captains will nominate their teams to the referee, assigning a letter to each individual player.

Doubles for a match do not need to be nominated until the end of the immediately preceding singles match.

The team competition will consist of two stages: the first phase (round Robin system) and the final phase (direct elimination system).

First stage (round robin system):

The teams will be divided into four groups of three, four or five teams, depending on the number of participants. All teams in the group will compete against each other and earn two (2) team points for a win, one (1) for a loss in a game played and zero (0) for a loss in a game not played or not finished. The teams will be ranked according to the number of points won.

If two or more teams are tied with the same number of points, the matches will be decided according to the rules of the ITTF.

The order of the matches of each group in the first stage (round robin system) will be as follows:

• **1st round:** 1 v 3 and 2 v 4 • **2nd round:** 1 v 2 and 3 v 4 • **3rd round:** 1 v 4 and 2 v 3

The top two teams from each group will advance to the finals.

Last step

The ranked teams will play in direct elimination (single elimination): quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals (bronze, silver and gold medals). The winners of the quarter-finals will play in the semi-finals. The winners of the semi-finals will compete for the gold medals. The losers of the semi-finals will compete for the bronze medals.

7.4.1. Consolation tournament:

All players who do not qualify for the second stage can participate in a consolation tournament for men or women. The consolation tournament will take place depending on the number of players. The consolation tournament system will be the knockout system and all matches will be the best of five (05) sets.

8. Competition venue:

The Table Tennis competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Mohammed ben Ahmed CCO **Hall 01 and 02**, 6,7 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village. The hall has a capacity of 1500 spectators.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition hall with a capacity of 500 spectators will have twelve (12) tables:

- Eight (08) 14m X 07m play areas

All tables must be approved by the ITTF.

8.2 Warm-up area:

Attached to the competition venue, the athletes will have a warm-up room which will have twelve (08) tables.

- Eight (08) 12m X 06m playing areas.

8.3 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

8.4 Rest room for athletes:

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.5 Press tribune:

Accredited media will have a tribune and a working room at their disposal.

8.6 Sports equipment:

All sports equipment and technical equipment used in table tennis competitions and training must comply with the standards established in the ITTF regulations, in force from **January 1, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

9. Training:

9.1 Training venues:

Table Tennis training for the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the following venues:

During the competition, the warm-up room at the Oran Mohammed Ben Ahmed Convention Center will be available for training at times that will ensure the best conditions for the players.

9.2 Services in training venue:

9.2.1 Changing rooms:

The participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

9.2.2 Rest room for athletes:

In the training venues, athletes will have a rest room with water, energy drinks and fruits.

9.3 Media during training:

The training sessions will be open to the media but not to the public. The competition director will be the person empowered to modify this standard whenever necessary.

9.4 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:

The NOCs will receive the program of the training sessions at the latest **Ten (10) Days** before the DRM.

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM.

9.4.1 Pre-competition:

In general, the direction of the competition will make available to the athletes, for a daily training session, the venue designated for this purpose, Three (3) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Thursday 23 June 2022**.

If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venues for training Four (4) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Wednesday 22 June 2022**. **According to the availability of the infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Head of Mission's Manual.**

The training sessions will last one hour and thirty minutes (1h30).

9.4.2 During the competition:

The competition management will assign a daily training session of one hour and thirty minutes (1:30) in the warm-up room.

During the technical meeting on **Saturday June 25, 2022**, the Organizing Committee will present the training program for the competition phase. During the technical meeting, each NOC will then be able to present their specific training needs, which will be assessed for inclusion in the training program for the competition phase.

All NOCs will have to confirm that they will use their training session, by 5:00 pm the day before training; otherwise, said session will be made available to other NOCs. They may also request, before 5:00 p.m., additional training which may be allocated to them, from 8:00 p.m. on the same day, depending on the availability of the venues.

The teams will receive information on the training sessions upon arrival at the Sports Information Center SIC of the Mediterranean Village and at the Table Tennis Technical Information Center TIC.

10. Participation:

All the member NOCs of the ICMG whose national federation is a member of the ITTF, will be able to participate in the table tennis competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

Athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and comply with the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the ITTF.

Each NOC may participate in the Table Tennis competition with two (2) men players and two (2) women players for the individual event, as well as with one team of both sexes in the team event.

The maximum number of participants per country will be 03 men and 03 women in total (06).

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system.

The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: sportsinscription@oran2022.com

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

The confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and all possible subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given in advance to the Heads of Mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on **Saturday June 25, 2022 at 09:00 a.m.**, at the Hall of the Oran Mohammed Ben Ahmed Convention Center.

The meeting will be conducted in accordance with ITTF rules, under the direction of the ITTF Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The ITTF Technical Delegate,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The manager of the ITTF competition,
- Referee appointed by the ITTF,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- Coaches (one per team),
- The Director of the Table Tennis competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

13. Health services:**13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venues:**

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

The Mediterranean Village polyclinic will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will act as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

13.2 Doping control:

Doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the Medical and Anti-Doping Commission of the ICMG and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of the OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the ITTF and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned (as well as his team) in accordance with the rules of the CIJM and ITTF.

14. Judges-referees:

14.1 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of the events of each sport on the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, international appeal judges will be appointed to deal with any claims.

If the ITTF Technical Delegate does not chair the Jury of Appeal, the ITTF will appoint, through him, the President of the Jury which will be composed according to the regulations in force.

As a general rule, and except as otherwise provided by the ITTF, a Jury of Appeal will be composed of one (1) President and two (2) members chosen from a list of six (6) qualified persons from among the representatives of the participating countries.

The list of members of the Jury of Appeal will be communicated by the Technical Delegate during the technical meeting.

14.2 Referees:

The ITTF will appoint one (1) referee and two (2) assistant referees. The referee must be of the international category. They will be responsible for the smooth running of the competition and will take care of the draws with the collaboration of the competition director.

Each NOC participating in the Table Tennis competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must register, with its delegation, an international referee to officiate during the competition. The name of the arbitrator must appear on the personal entry form.

To referee Table Tennis competitions, twenty (20) teams of two (2) referees each will be formed.

The FATT, under the control of the ITTF, may appoint additional international referees necessary for the smooth running of the competition.

Officials' clothing will be provided by the OCMG Oran 2022.

15. Claims:

All claims must comply with ITTF procedures. Claims must be presented, by the NOC in question, in writing, in Arabic, French or English, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the ITTF regulations.

All claims will be presented to the Table Tennis TIC, which will in turn forward them to the secretariat of the Jury of Appeal, as well as to the Technical Commission of the ICMG.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

16. Rackets' control:

The ITTF, in agreement with the FATT, will designate one (1) person to control the rackets. This person will control the rackets in accordance with applicable ITTF standards.

17. Sports clothing:

Participants in the table tennis competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with ITTF and ICMG regulations.

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, provided that it does not appear exaggeratedly for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and the ITTF.

The official medal ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising. The athletes will have to stand on the podium with the official clothing of their NOC.

17.1 Bibs:

Athletes will not wear numbers but their names must be clearly visible on the back of their official competition jersey.

18. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

18.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations.

18.1.1 First place:

Gold medal and diploma to the participant or members of each team ranked first.

18.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal and diploma to the participant or members of each team ranked second.

18.1.3 Third place:

Bronze medal and diploma to the participant or members of each team ranked third.

18.1.4 Fourth to eighth place:

Diploma to the participant or members of each team ranked fourth to eighth place.

19. Calendar and schedule:

The Table Tennis competition will take place from **Sunday June 26 to Thursday June 30, 2022**, according to the following times (the times are provisional and may change depending on the final number of entries:

- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

21. Approval of regulations:

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.
