4. Events and dates:

4.1 Sports program:

The Archery competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

4.2 Dates and venue:

The Archery competition will take place at the Annex Stadium of the Olympic Complex from **Tuesday 28 June 2022 to Friday 1st 2022.**

5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:

The Archery competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men events and six (6) countries for the women events have registered before **11:59 p.m. (Algerian time) on Friday March 25, 2022.**

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the ICMG Technical Commission assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the President of the ICMG, and in the presence of the Sport Director of the OCMG Oran 2022, will decide on **Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

5.1 Cancellation of events:

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee (NOC) of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

6. Competition rules:

The Archery competition will be held in accordance with the WA regulations in force on **January 01, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, WA rules will apply.

7. Technical organization:

FATS under the supervision of the WA Technical Delegate, is responsible for the technical organization and conduct of the Archery competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition management, in accordance with the regulations of the ICMG and the WA in force on **January 1, 2022**, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The precise arrangements for the organization of the Archery competition will be made according to the number of participants.

7.2 Competition system:

The competition will be divided into three (3) phases: qualification, elimination and a final.

In the qualification phase, the archers shoot 72 arrows, in volleys of 6 arrows, at 70m distance, on targets of 122 centimeters.

All participants will shoot at the same ground and from the shooting line depending on the number of archers.

The "WA" system will be used in the elimination phases and the finals, both for the individual tournament and for the team tournament.

The individual elimination will be played by a set system. Each set will consist of one end of three (3) arrows per archer. Each set won will give the archer two (2) set points and the tied sets will give each archer one (1) set point. The first archer who scores six (6) points will win the match, with a maximum of five (5) innings. In the event of a tie after the five (5) innings, only one (1) SHOOT OFF arrow will be shot to break the tie.

Depending on the number of participating teams, the direct passage (bye) will be allowed.

The team playoffs will be run by set scores. Each team will shoot a maximum of four (4) ends of six (6) arrows in total, that is, two (2) arrows per archer. The first team to reach five (5) set points will win the match. In the event of a tie, a series of extra sets will be performed in which each archer shoots only one (1) arrow; the team with the highest score of the sum of the three (3) arrows per team will win; in the event of a tie, the team with the arrow closest to the center wins. If there was a tie again, at the same distance it would go to the next nearest distance and so until the final tie.

8. Competition Venue:

The Archery competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at **the Annex Stadium of the Olympic Complex, 04 km** from the Mediterranean Village. The stadium has a capacity of **500 spectators**.

8.1 Competition area:

The competition area will consist of:

8.1.1 Competition ground for qualification round:

Oriented to the north measuring approximately 60 x 120 m of artificial grass equipped with an athlete's shelter for each shooting line.

8.1.2 Warm-up ground:

A training ground annexed to the competition area, equipped with targets at 70 and 10 meters.

8.1.2.1 Services in the training venue:

8.1.2.2 Changing rooms:

Participants will have changing rooms for men and women equipped with showers and W.C.

8.1.2.3 Rest room:

At the training venue, athletes will have a rest room, where water, energy drinks and fruits will be available.

8.2 Changing rooms:

Participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

8.3 Rest room for athletes:

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

8.4 Press tribune:

The accredited media will have at their disposal a tribune and a working room.

8.5 Sports equipment store:

Each NOC will have a reserved space in the venue to store competition material, this space will always be supervised.

8.6 Sport equipment:

All sports equipment, technical equipment and uniforms used in Archery competitions and training by shooters and team officials must meet the standards established in the WA regulations, in effect on **January 01, 2022**, except exceptions authorized by the ICMG. A review of this equipment will be carried out by the judges' committee appointed during official training, on the competition ground, on **Tuesday 28 June, 2022**.

9. Training:

9.1 Training venue:

Archery training for the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Annex Stadium of the Olympic Complex, 04 km kilometers from the Mediterranean Village.

9.1.1 Training calendar and schedule:

9.2 Media during training:

The training sessions will be open to the media but not to the public. The Competition Director will be the person empowered to modify this standard whenever necessary.

The media will have at their disposal a "media line" area one (1) meter wide, located behind the shooting line.

9.3 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:

NOCs will receive the program of training sessions at the latest **Ten (10) Days before** the DRM.

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM.

9.3.1 Pre-competition:

In general, the competition management will make available to the teams, for a daily training session, the venue designated for this purpose, three (3) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, on **25, 26 and 27 June 2022**, During the official training, the revision of the material will take place in the own venue.

If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venue for training five (5) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, from **Thursday 23 June 2022**. **Depending on the availability of infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Heads of Mission Manual.**

9.3.2 During the competition:

The Competition management will assign a daily training session of one hour and thirty minutes, in the venue designated for this purpose.

During the technical meeting on **Monday, June 27, 2022**, the Organizing Committee will present the training program for the competition phase. During the technical meeting, each NOC will then be able to present their specific training needs, which will be assessed for inclusion in the training program for the competition phase.

Teams will receive information on the training sessions upon arrival at the Sports Information Center SIC of the Mediterranean Village and at the Archery Technical Information Center TIC).

10. Participation:

All member NOCs of the ICMG, of which the national archery federation is a member of the WA, will be able to participate in the Archery competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

Athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and comply with the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the WA.

Each NOC will have the right to enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per category and gender. All registered athletes will participate in the individual competition and may participate with three (3) athletes in the same category in the team competition.

11. Entries:

11.1 General principles:

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

11.2 Procedures:

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system.

The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow printing a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022:

11.2.1 Entries by number:

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, before **23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022, no later than **Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form of the nominative and final entries of their participants, through the online application.

11.3 Confirmation of entries:

Confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and any subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given to the head of mission of each NOC.

12. Technical meeting:

The technical meeting will take place on **Monday June 27, 2022 at 11:00 a.m.**, at the meeting room of the Mediterranean Village.

The meeting will be conducted in accordance with WA rules, under the direction of the WA Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The WA Technical Delegate,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- Coaches (one per team),
- The members of the competition judges committee,
- The Director of the Archery competition of OCMG Oran 2022.

12.1 Assignment of targets:

The draw for the assignment of competition targets will take place the day before the technical meeting, that is to say, on **Sunday June 26, 2022 at 03:00 p.m.**, at the meeting room of the Mediterranean Village. The list will be available at the TIC of the competition site, at the SIC of the Mediterranean Village and online.

13. Health services:

13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at competition venue:

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:

The Mediterranean Village polyclinic will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will serve as a link between the polyclinic and the main hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

13.1.2 Competition venue:

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venue.

13.2 Doping control:

Anti-doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the WA and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned, as will the other members of his team (in case of team participation), in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the WA.

14. Judges-referees:

The WA will nominate a team of international judges, with additional support from Algerian judges appointed by the FATS National Judges Committee.

14.1 Jury of Appeal:

In accordance with the technical regulations of each event included in the program of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, an international Jury of Appeal will be formed in order to resolve the claims.

If the WA Technical Delegate does not chair the Jury of Appeal, the WA will appoint, through him, the President of the jury which will be composed according to the regulations in force.

As a general rule, and except as otherwise provided in the WA, the Jury of Appeal will be composed of one (1) President and two (2) members and one (1) alternate chosen from among the representatives of the participating countries.

The list of members of the Jury of Appeal will be communicated by the Technical Delegates during the technical meeting.

When processing a claim, the members of the appeal jury, nationals of the countries concerned, must be replaced.

14.2 Judges:

The WA will appoint a sufficient number of international judges for the smooth running of the competition. These judges will be assisted by Algerian judges appointed by the FATS.

15. Claims:

All claims will have to comply with WA procedures. Claims must be presented, by the NOC in question, in writing, in Arabic, French or English, within the required time limits, accompanied by a deposit in cash fixed by the regulations of the WA.

All claims will be presented to the Archery TIC who will forward them to the technical delegate of the international federation, to the competition director or to the President of the Archery Judging Commission who will forward them to the Jury of Appeal.

If a claim is successful, the deposit will be refunded, but not otherwise.

16. Sports clothing:

16.1 Sports clothing for archers:

Participants in the Archery competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with the regulations of the WA and the ICMG. No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, provided that it is not exaggeratedly displayed for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules set by the ICMG and the WA.

The official medal ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and publicity. The athletes will have to stand on the podium with the official clothing of their NOC.

16.2 Clothing of the referees:

During the competition, the international referees must wear the regulation uniforms of the WA.

16.3 Bibs:

The bibs provided by the OCMG Oran 2022, worn by the participants must be fully visible throughout the duration of the competition, as stipulated by the WA regulations.

Bibs will be given to the team managers at the Archery TIC located in Annex Stadium of the Olympic Complex.

17. Medal ceremonies:

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

17.1 Medals and diplomas:

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

17.1.1 First place:

Gold medal and diploma to the archer or to each member of the team ranked first.

17.1.2 Second place:

Silver medal and diploma to the archer or to each member of the team ranked second.

17.1.3 Third place:

Bronze medal and diploma to the archer or to each member of the team ranked third.

17.1.4 Fourth to eighth place:

Diploma to archers or to each member of the teams ranked from fourth to eighth place.

18. Calendar and schedule:

The Archery competition will take place from **Tuesday 28 June to Friday 1st July 2022**, according to the following schedules (schedules are provisional and may change depending on the final number of entries:

The organizers, and for justified reasons, will also have the right to modify the competition schedules, with the agreement of the Technical Delegate.

Each team or athlete concerned would then be informed at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance.

19. Technical offices:

Two offices will provide information specific to the Archery competition:

- TIC of Archery, located at the competition site.
- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

These offices will provide information on competition schedules, training sessions, transportation, participant lists and results.

20. Approval of regulations:

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.

This Technical Manual was approved by the ICMG on March 12, 2022.
