The Sailing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will include the following events:

## **4.2 Dates and venue:**

The sailing competition will take place at the Nautical Base Les Andalouses **from Monday June 27, 2022 to Sunday July 3, 2022.**

## **5. Conditions for the conduct of the competition:**

The sailing competition will take place if a minimum of eight (8) countries for the men's events and six (6) countries for the women's events have registered **before 11:59 p.m. (Algerian time) on Friday March 25, 2022.**

Depending on the number of entries, the President of the Technical Commission of the ICMG, assisted by one (1) or two (2) members of this commission appointed by the president of the ICMG, and in the presence of the president of the commission of the sports organization of the OCMG Oran 2022, will decide, **on Monday May 30, 2022**, the list of canceled events.

Once the progress of a competition has been confirmed, it will take place and the corresponding medals and diplomas will be distributed, regardless of the number of participants.

### **5.1 Cancellation of events:**

The OCMG Oran 2022 will immediately inform each National Olympic Committee (NOC) of the list of events that have been canceled because they do not meet the required number of participants.

## **6. Competition rules:**

The Sailing competition will be held in accordance with the WS rules and the class rules in force on January 1, 2022, with special exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

Questions not addressed in this technical manual will be resolved as follows:

- For general questions, the ICMG rules will apply.
- For technical matters, WS rules will apply.

## **7. Technical organization:**

The ASF, under the supervision of the Technical Delegate of the WS, is responsible for the technical organization and running of the sailing competition during the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

### **7.1 Special provisions regarding the conduct of the competition:**

Any problems that may arise before or during the events will be resolved by the Competition management, in accordance with the regulations of the ICMG and the WS in force on January 1, 2022, except for specific exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

The precise arrangements for the organization of the sailing competition will be made according to the number of participants.

### **7.2 Competition System:**

The competition system will follow the WS rules for each class, as well as the racing instructions.

Each athlete will participate individually, in his class and category. The competition will be organized in a single series.

Eleven (11) races will be on the series program. A minimum of four (4) races must be held to validate the competition.

The starting order, which will always be separated between men and women, will be established by the chairman of the race committee

The sailing instructions will set the maximum time limit for the duration of the events, as well as an estimate of their duration (Target time).

### **7.3 Sailing boats:**

- The OCMG Oran 2022 will not provide any IQFOIL STARBOARD
- The OCMG Oran2022 will supply the LASER boats (Charter)
- Participants will have to bring their life jacket, system and sail for LASER.

NOCs will be able to book LASER boats and COACH boats once their entries for the games have been validated.

If an IQFOIL board is available, the NOCs will be notified for reservations.

The gauge will be done according to the program on the notice of race.

### **7.4 Dimensions of sailing boats:**

The boats will have to respect the regulatory measures of the WS and the class rules.

**7.5 Race instructions:**

The sailing instructions will be given to each country participating in the sailing competition, at the venue of the competition, after entries.

**8. Competition venue:**

The sailing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Nautical Base Les Andalouses, 46 Km kilometers from the Mediterranean Village.

**8.1 Competition area:**

The competition area will be located in the Les Andalouses nautical base area with previous WS approval.

**8.2 Warm-up area:**

The warm-up area will be the same for the competition.

**8.3 Changing rooms:**

The participants will have at their disposal male and female changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

**8.4 Rest room for athletes:**

Athletes will have a rest room equipped with water, energy drinks and fruits.

**8.5 Storage space:**

On the competition venue, a space for storing and rinsing equipment (Boat shed).

**8.6 Sport equipment:**

All sports equipment and technical equipment used during sailing competitions and training must comply with the standards established by the regulations of the WS, and of the classes in force **on January 1, 2022**, with exceptions authorized by the ICMG.

## **9. Training:**

### **9.1 Training venue:**

Sailing training for the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 will take place at the Nautical Base Les Andalouses , 46 kilometers from the Mediterranean Village.

### **9.1.1 Training calendar and schedule:**

Athletes will have the following venues at their disposal, according to the times indicated below:

### **9.2 Services in training venues:**

#### **9.2.1 Changing rooms:**

The participants will have at their disposal men and women changing rooms equipped with showers and toilets.

#### **9.2.2 Rest room for athletes:**

In the training venues, athletes will have a rest room with water, energy drinks and fruits.

### **9.3 Media during training:**

The training sessions will be open to the media according to the regulations in force (WS).

## **9.4 Procedure for assignments of training sessions:**

The NOCs will receive the program of training sessions **at the latest Ten (10) Days** before DRM

They will need to confirm that they will use the sessions assigned to them during the DRM

### **9.4.1 Pre-competition:**

In general, the competition management will make available to the athletes, for a daily training session, the venues designated for this purpose, **Three (3) days before** the start of the competition, that is to say , **June 24, 25 and 26, 2022**

If they have requested them during the DRM, following the established procedure, the delegations will be able to use the venues for training **five (5) days before the start of the competition, that is to say, on Wednesday 22 June 2022, depending on the availability of infrastructure and in accordance with the criteria mentioned in the Heads of Mission Manual.**

## **10. Participation:**

All member NOCs of the ICMG, whose national federation is a member of the WS, will be able to participate in the sailing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

The athletes who will participate in the competitions must have the nationality of the country they represent and respect the conditions and regulations of the ICMG and the WS.

Each NOC can participate in the Sailing competition with:

- two STD athletes,
- two RADIAL athletes,
- two IQFOIL men windsurfing athletes,
- two IQFOIL women windsurfing athletes.

## **11. Entries:**

### **11.1 General principles:**

The XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 is open to all athletes from NOCs of Mediterranean member countries of the ICMG, according to the standards of the ICMG Charter and the IOC.

All athletes participating in the Games must be citizens of the country they represent, in accordance with the IOC rules.

Prior to the Games, all participating athletes must complete and sign the "consent form" as defined by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

## **11.2 Procedures:**

The delegation registration process is linked to the general accreditation system. The registration system set up by the OCMG Oran 2022 consists of an online computer application, accessible through the official Games' website: <https://entriesoran2022.dz>

Each delegation will have a user name and a password of their own which will allow them to access the online application in Two Languages: English and French.

The online application will allow to print a list of sports entries which, once signed, must be sent, before the deadlines indicated hereafter, to the OCMG Oran 2022: [sportsinscription@oran2022.com](mailto:sportsinscription@oran2022.com)

### **11.2.1 Entries by number:**

The list of entries with the number of participants per sport and per event must be submitted, through the online application, **before 23:59 (Algerian time), on Friday March 25, 2022.**

### **11.2.2 Preliminary entries by name (Long list):**

The list of preliminary entries of participants by name, by sport and by event must be submitted, through the online application, **before 23:59 (Algerian time) on Friday, April 15, 2022.**

### **11.2.3 Final entries by name (Short list):**

The NOCs of all participating countries must send to the OCMG Oran 2022 **no later than Thursday May 26, 2022 (23:59 Algerian time)**, the form for the nominative and definitive entries of their participants, through the online application

## **11.3 Confirmation of entries:**

The confirmation of entries will take place during the DRM and all possible subsequent eligible changes will be presented to the SIC and confirmed, at the latest, during the technical meeting.

The specific forms for the confirmation of entries will be given in advance to the Head of Mission of each NOC.

## **12. Technical meeting:**

The technical meeting will take place on **Sunday June 26, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.** at the competition venue.



The meeting will take place in accordance with the WS rules, under the direction of the WS Technical Delegate. The following people should be present at this meeting:

- The Technical Delegate of the WS,
- A member of the ICMG Technical Commission,
- The team leaders (one per country),
- Coaches (one per team),
- Team doctors (one per team),
- The Director of the Sailing competition of the OCMG Oran 2022.

### **13. Health services**

#### **13.1 Medical services available in the Village and at the competition venues:**

During the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022, health assistance will be available for any athlete or accredited official who needs it, both in the Mediterranean Village and at all competition venues.

##### **13.1.1 Mediterranean Village:**

The Mediterranean Village polyclinic will provide residents with the following health services:

- Sports medicine,
- Physiotherapy,
- First aid,
- 24 hour emergency services.

Ambulance teams will act as a link between the polyclinic and the referral hospitals, in the event that additional care is required.

##### **13.1.2 Competition venue:**

During the course of the events, all competition venues will have the following services available to athletes:

- Medical services,
- Medical transport service.

Coolers filled with ice cubes will be made available to delegations in all sports venues.

### **13.2 Doping control:**

Anti-doping controls will be carried out during competition or out of competition, under the responsibility of the ICMG Medical and Anti-Doping Commission and with the collaboration of the anti-doping services of OCMG Oran 2022, in accordance with the rules of the ICMG, the WS and the World Anti-Doping Code.

Each participant subject to a control will receive a written notification, at which point the procedure for collecting the control sample will begin, and this, within the times and in the manner established by law.

The athlete who refuses to submit to a doping control procedure, or who has a positive analysis of his sample, will be excluded from the competition and will be sanctioned (as well as his team) in accordance with the rules of the ICMG and the WS.

## **14. Jury and referees:**

### **14.1 Jury**

An international jury will be appointed in accordance with the rules of the WS and must be approved by the latter. The decisions of this jury will be final (rule RRS 70.5). A race committee will also be set up under the responsibility of the Technical Delegate of the WS.

The jury will be composed with a minimum of Three international Jury.

### **14.2 Referees:**

The ASF will appoint all the referees for the Sailing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022.

## **15. Claims:**

Claims will be dealt with according to the WS racing rules by an international jury with no possibility of appeal.

## **16. Sports clothing:**

Participants in the Sailing competition of the XIX Mediterranean Games Oran 2022 must wear sports clothing in accordance with the regulations of the WS and the ICMG.

No advertising marks are permitted on sportswear, accessories or, as a general rule, on any part of the clothing or equipment worn or used by athletes. Only the name of the manufacturer of the corresponding garment or equipment will be allowed, provided it does not appear exaggeratedly for advertising purposes, in accordance with the rules defined by the ICMG and the WS.

The official Medal Ceremony will be subject to the same regulations as regards sports attire and advertising.

## **17. Medal ceremonies:**

Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

### **17.1 Medals and diplomas:**

The following prizes will be awarded, in accordance with the ICMG regulations:

#### **17.1.1 First place:**

Gold medal and diploma for the first placed participant.

#### **17.1.2 Second place:**

Silver medal and diploma for the second placed participant.

#### **17.1.3 Third place:**

Bronze medal and diploma to the participant ranked third.

#### **17.1.4 Fourth to eighth place:**

Diploma to participants ranked from fourth to eighth place.

## **18. Calendar and schedule:**

The Sailing competition will take place from **Monday June 27 to Sunday July 3, 2022**, according to the following schedules (schedules are provisional and may change depending on the final number of entries:

The organizers, and for justified reasons, will also have the right to modify the competition schedules, with the agreement of the Technical Delegate.

Each team or athlete concerned would then be informed at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance.

### **19. Technical offices:**

Two offices will provide information specific to the sailing competition:

- TIC of sailing, located on the competition site.
- SIC of the Mediterranean Village.

These offices will provide information on competition schedules, training sessions, transportation, participant lists and results.

- Race pc located on the competition site,
- Secretariat located on the competition site,
- Meeting room located on the competition site,
- Jury at the competition site.

### **20. Approval of regulations:**

In the event of disagreement on the interpretation of the text of this manual with any other related version, the French text shall prevail.

This Technical Manual was approved by the ICMG on March 12, 2022.
